


Executive Director, Sarah Farr


"Speech and language communication enables children to build positive relationships, form friendships and learn by listening, talking and questioning." Good speech, language and

communication skills have a positive impact on confidence and self-esteem. Their emotional strength and resilience develop from the success they have understanding others and communicating their own needs.



RiteCare by the Numbers




Approximately 390 volunteer hours, an economic equivalent of \$15K

Summer Groups

This summer saw the return of our beloved summer groups in both our Salt Lake and Ogden centers. This program is, by far, RiteCare of Utah's most in-demand program. We were so thrilled to be able to invite groups of children along with their caregivers back to our buildings!

RiteCare of Utah provided group speech-language therapy to 46 children this summer. Children were offered services in one of 3 groups: language, social skills or articulation.

Over the II-week program, children made an average gain of an 81% increase in targeted abilities.

Our parents are so dedicated to learning how to help their children in their home and school environment that our gains are truly remarkable!
